The seminar will include:

South American annuals, and the African genera Nothobranchius and Fundulopanchax. Greg will discuss the different reproductive strategies of annuals, which are often considered difficult fish to spawn.

Greg has been a member of the American Killifish Association for many years and has kept, and spawned, many killifishes, and other tropical fishes, such as Discus and Cardinal Tetras.

Regarded as an authority on the genus Fundulopanchax, he is a Senior Judge of the AKA, a sitting member of the Board of Trustees, and a Technical Editor of the Journal of the American Killifish Association. He has written many articles on killifishes for JAKA and trade magazines such as Tropical Fish Hobbyist and Amazonas.
